### CYBERATTACK SURGE HIGHLIGHTS URGENT NEED FOR SECURE, REDUNDANT MESSAGING



The UK's National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC) has reported a 50% surge in the number of cyber incidents categorized as "highly significant". These high-impact attacks have targeted organizations that form the backbone of the UK's critical national infrastructure, including healthcare, utilities, and emergency systems.

While the NCSC's increased response reflects the nation's evolving cyber-defense strategy, it also underscores a growing concern: the reliability and continuity of communication during an active cyber event. When digital networks are compromised or congested, the ability to deliver messages through a secure, isolated, and redundant communication channel becomes essential.

For members of the Critical Messaging Association, this rise serves as a clear "call to action". Paging and critical messaging networks by design, operating independently of the public internet and cellular systems offer a resilient communication backbone when other platforms are down.

Maintaining these independent infrastructures isn't simply about tradition; it's about ensuring operational continuity and public safety when conventional networks fail. As cyber threats grow more sophisticated, redundancy, isolation, and secure fallback systems remain core principles of resilient communication strategy.



**The takeaway**: in an era of increasing cyber volatility, trusted critical messaging networks are not a relic of the past, they are the safety net for the future.
